NEW FLORIDA SECRETARY OF COMMERCE AND ENTERPRISE FLORIDA, INC. PRESIDENT AND CEO LAURA DIBELLA TO KICK OFF 2023 FLORIDA SUPPLY CHAIN SUMMIT

DiBella will deliver opening remarks and introduce the 2023 Florida Supply Chain Summit's first panel discussion focused on Florida.

TAMPA, FL — The Florida Supply Chain Summit is honored to have newly appointed Florida Secretary of Commerce and Enterprise Florida, Inc. (EFI), President and CEO Laura DiBella delivering the kickoff address at its annual summit on May 15, 2023, in Tampa. DiBella will offer opening remarks to get the summit started and introduce the first session which will feature a panel discussion with the Florida Ports Association, EFI, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), the Florida Chamber, and the Florida Department of Education with Doug Davidson from Bank of America (BOA) serving as panel moderator.



DiBella is the first female Secretary of Commerce for Florida and had been serving as Assistant Secretary of Commerce since July 2022. She was responsible for assisting companies in relocating to Florida and expanding business for those already in the state. DiBella has significant experience in the high-profile recruitment and expansion of projects encompassing manufacturing, corporate headquarters, healthcare, and logistics. Other key highlights in DiBella's career include:

- Organizing the Southeastern United States-Japan conference, bringing Florida Governor Ron DeSantis and leading officials from Japan, including Koji Tomita, Ambassador to the United States, together along with key Japanese business leaders.
- Previously serving as the first full-time Executive Director of the Florida Harbor Pilots
 Association where she oversaw Florida's 14 operating deepwater seaports ensuring a
 continuous flow of commerce.
- Serving as the Executive Director of the Nassau County Economic Development Board and as Port Director for the Port of Fernandina, Ocean Highway, and Port Authority of Nassau County.
